After controlling our jobs for more than 20 years, Jimmy Pattison's company, the Overwaitea Food Group, is directly responsible for the permanent closure of its Langley distribution center. At September's end, 250 hard-working, dedicated employees will lose their jobs to a low-wage Overwaitea Food Group contractor. Many of those who will lose their jobs were with Jimmy Pattison before his distribution warehouse was even built. Our average length of service is 17 years.

In spite of earning record profits from his Save-On-Foods stores, Jimmy Pattison is forcing the contracting out of our jobs to people who will work for less.

Even though, his managers deny that Jimmy is in the warehouse business, we know that he has full control the distribution process.

If you buy from Jimmy Pattison's Save-On-Foods today, know that your groceries came from the warehouse Jimmy controls!

"This is nothing more than a cruel little shell game being played by a very profitable company that is prepared to treat its work force with the utmost contempt," says Brooke Sundin, UFCW 1518 President. "Overwaitea/Save On simply wants to increase its already substantial profits at the expense of its warehouse workers."

We have done everything to convince our employer not to give our jobs away. We offered to re-negotiate our contract, but the extremely wealthy Jimmy Pattison seems interested in nothing more than shifting our jobs to a low-wage center.

We continue to attempt to find non-confrontational solutions to this attack on our livelihoods, our homes and the future of our families, but we have been left with no choice but to ask you to spend your money with a fair employer.
